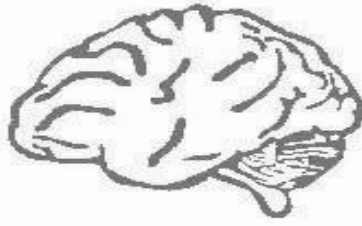
The Society for Clinical Neuropsychology:
