

APPCN:

- ◆ Is a professional organization for postdoctoral training programs in Clinical Neuropsychology.
- ◆ Continues to attract new member programs.
- ◆ Accepts programs that exemplify clinical, academic, training and leadership excellence.
- ◆ Verifies that member programs provide postdoctoral training consistent with the Houston Conference guidelines.
- ◆ Specifies a unified competency-based curriculum.
- ◆ Assures that graduates will meet ABPP-CN credentialing requirements.
- ◆ Provides a national fellowship match process to facilitate the application/ interviewing process.
- ◆ Views the American Board of Professional Psychology diploma in Clinical Neuropsychology (ABPP-CN) as the clearest demonstration of peer-reviewed competence to practice clinical neuropsychology.



Why Should Students Commit to the APPCN Match?

APPCN Member programs commit to a standardized curriculum, have access to unique training resources, and offer advanced training opportunities to support APPCN graduates in their pursuit of ABPP-CN.

Graduation from one of our programs provides complete assurance that residents will meet or exceed ABPP-CN credential requirements, because APPCN member programs must demonstrate that they conform to Houston Conference guidelines.

Neuropsychology job announcements often require “graduation from an APPCN training program.” Graduates of APPCN fellowships are uniformly viewed as having met this eligibility requirement.



Who can apply to APPCN training programs?

Doctoral graduate students who have completed their coursework and internship training in neuropsychology are encouraged to apply (see our *Applicants FAQ* page on our website).

- ◆ Contact the individual training directors through the APPCN Member Programs page.
- ◆ Apply to individual training programs
- ◆ There is no fee to apply to specific programs.
- ◆ Go to www.appcn.org to register for the match. There is a fee to participate in the match.

The APPCN Match:

- ◆ Creates a competitive and fair process for students and programs.
- ◆ Establishes a schedule for the recruitment process.
- ◆ Respects and protects the student and the training program.

APPCN Programs Offer the Highest Quality in Neuropsychology Training!

APPCN programs commit to providing fellowship training to prepare fellows for independent practice and board certification. How do we do this?

- ◆ APPCN programs require a minimum of *4 hours* per week devoted to didactics, covering case presentations, neuropsychological syndromes, neuroanatomy, neurological conditions, ethics, professional issues and ABPP-CN board certification.
- ◆ APPCN programs require up to *4 hours* per week devoted to research. APPCN fellows often graduate with multiple publications.
- ◆ The combination of required didactics and research allows fellows to meet central tenets of the Houston Conference Guidelines (e.g., knowledge and skill).
- ◆ APPCN programs offer mock written and ethics vignettes, as well as mock oral board examinations.

Graduates of APPCN fellowships enjoy an expedited review when applying for ABPP-CN board.

APPCN member programs are required to have board certified training staff and in many cases there are several board certified staff members.


What kind of programs can join APPCN?

Training programs offering postdoctoral training in Clinical Neuropsychology and adhering to Houston Conference guidelines for postdoctoral programs are encouraged to apply.

Member programs apply to APPCN and are reviewed to ensure that graduates will:

- ◆ Have the necessary knowledge and skill required for independent practice as a neuropsychologist.
- ◆ Become sought-after neuropsychologists who are grounded in research and scholarly activity.
- ◆ Meet ABPP-CN board certification requirements.

The vast majority of fellowships accredited in clinical neuropsychology by the APA are APPCN member programs.
